

#### **TABLEAU**

http://artsintegration.com/ 100-strategies/ When creating a tableau, students explore various levels (sitting, standing, kneeling), use different body parts, and collaborate with classmates to create a scene. This technique might be used to assess students' comprehension of major plot points in a story and differing perspectives.

#### **TAPPING IN**

The teacher taps the shoulder of a student in the tableau to prompt them to share their character's perspective. This can be used to allow the teacher to assess a student's comprehension of character and plot.
