Objectives	translate current events into movement that articulates their stance on the issue chosen.
Learning Activities	 Have students research current events that they are passionate about. Either individually or in small groups, have students choose one event to depict their stance through movement. Build an artist intent based on their stance. What comment do they wish to make about the issue? Have students make artistic choices based on their stance. What structure would work best to articulate their opinion? What elements will enhance their perspective? What devices will communicate their thoughts? Have students build movement revolving around their intent. Once the study has been composed, have students write an artist statement describing and defending their decisions. Finally, have students perform their studies.
