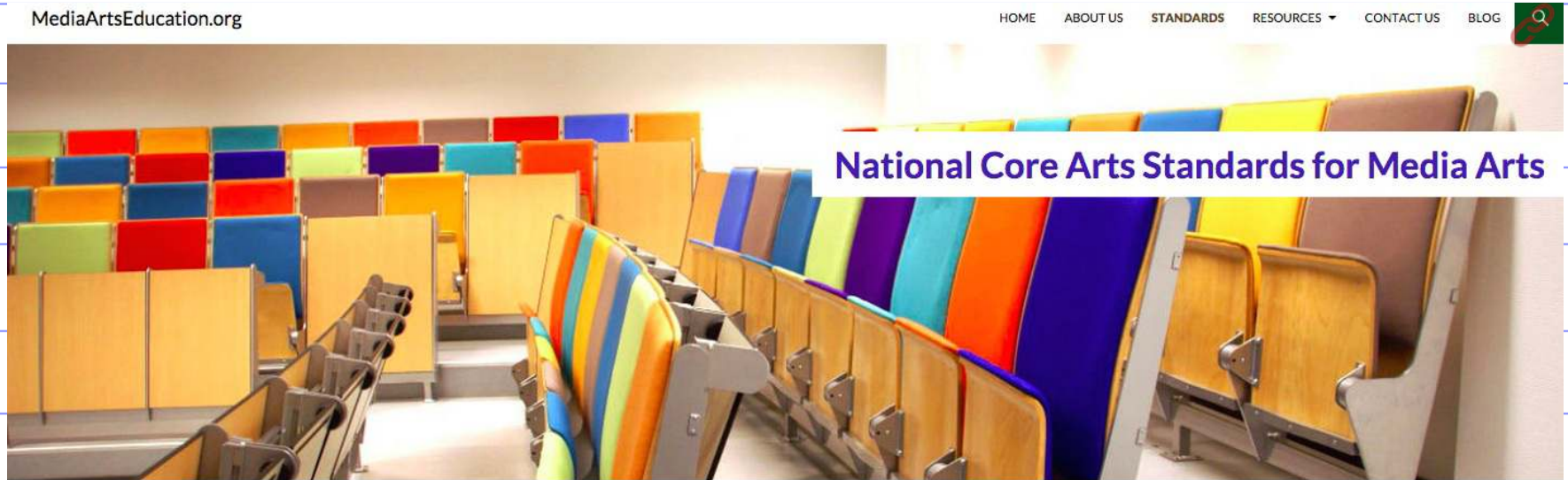




Media Arts Standards 6-4-14


