

## Develop Their Creative Process

**Creative Process:** the act of moving from inspiration and intent to creation of art through exploration, connection, experimentation, and evaluation.

<b>INTRODUCTION</b>	Student requires explicit direction to begin their creative process.	Student requires modeling to begin their creative process.	Student requires limited guidance to begin their creative process.	Student independently initiates their creative process.
<b>PROCESS</b>	Given a variety of options, student is unable to create with intent.	Given a variety of options, student creates with intent during some phases of their creative process.	Given a variety of options, student creates with intent during all phases of their creative process.	Regardless of options given, student creates with intent and individual purpose during all phases of their creative process.
<b>PRODUCT</b>	Student shows little recognition of their creative process and is unable to replicate it.	Student demonstrates a creative process but is unable to apply it to future experiences.	Student demonstrates all phases of their creative process and can apply it to future experiences.	Student demonstrates and articulates all phases of their creative process and consistently applies it to future experiences.
