Word	What it means
<b>prone</b>	likely to or liable to suffer from, do, or experience something, typically something regrettable or unwelcome
<b>strained</b>	showing signs of tiredness or nervous tension
<b>revolutionaries</b>	a person who works for or engages in political revolution
<b>paralysis</b>	the loss of the ability to move in part or most of the body
<b>reclusive</b>	avoiding the company of other people; solitary
<b>political activism</b>	the use of active and forceful campaigns to create awareness about political issues
<b>conservative</b>	avoiding change and holding traditional values
<b>philosophy</b>	the study of the basic nature of knowledge, reality, and existence
<b>impaled</b>	pierced with a sharp instrument
<b>fatigue</b>	extreme tiredness
<b>confines</b>	restrain or forbid someone from leaving a place
<b>mural</b>	a painting or other work of art executed directly on a wall
<b>surrealism</b>	a 20th-century movement in art and literature which wanted to release the creative potential of the unconscious mind
<b>deteriorate</b>	become progressively worse
