Great Depression	the worst economic downturn in the history of the industrialized world, lasting from 1929 to 1939
segregation	the enforced separation of different racial groups in a country, community, or establishment
domestic	relating to the running of a home or to family relations
solace	comfort or consolation in a time of distress or sadness.
vaudeville	a type of entertainment popular chiefly in the US in the early 20th century, featuring a mixture of specialty acts such as comedy, song and dance
troupe	a group of dancers, actors, or other entertainers who tour to different theatres
earnest	happening to a greater extent or more intensely than before
recruited	persuade (someone) to do or assist in doing something
commissioned	a work of art produced specially to order
