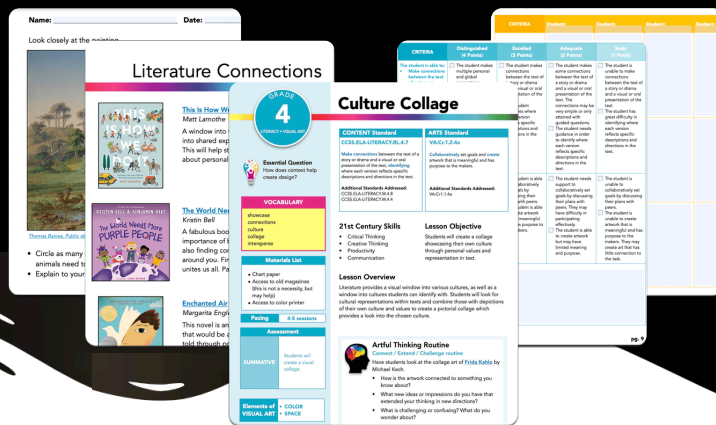

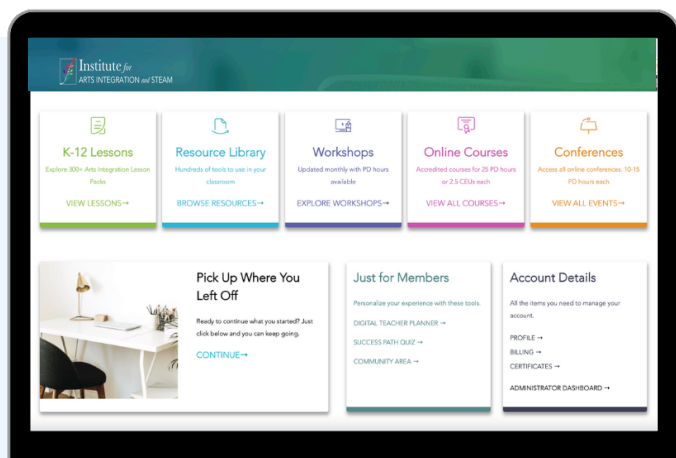

FAQ SHEET

Q: When will my team receive access to the Accelerator?

Upon receipt of payment, your group leader will receive access to being planning with their success guide. The rest of the group will receive access once the planning stage is complete with your personal success guide. The one-year membership clock does not start until your ENTIRE group is given access to the platform.

Q: Is everything included with Accelerator membership or does PD cost extra?

Yes! When we say "all-inclusive" we mean all-inclusive! The membership includes unlimited access to everything on the platform during the duration of your membership. That includes the six-25 hour accredited PD courses as well as 300+ lesson packs, workshops, virtual conferences, templates/worksheets, and so much more!

Q: Is there a master shopping list with all of the supplies needed to carry out your lesson plans?

Not yet but we are working on one. Keep in mind, we created our lesson plans with accessibility and equity in mind. Most lessons require materials that should already be on hand at most schools. In addition, any reference to artwork or videos will already be linked to right in the lesson.

Q: What is a success guide and how will I meet with them?

A **Success Guide** is a certified Arts Integration/STEAM specialist that knows the ins and outs of the Accelerator platform. They're there to make sure you and your team get exactly what you need from the plethora of content in the Accelerator. Groups of 10-19 receive electronic consultation and a personalized year-long guide map based on that consultation. Groups of 20 or more receive full support with a dedicated support guide, consultation call, quarterly check-ins, and a monthly recommendation guide sheet.

Q: How do I pay for my group membership?

To get the ball rolling, contact our Chief Growth Officer, Kevin Riley, by emailing kevin@artsintegration.com. Once we gather some information from you, we will be able to send you an invoice via email. Invoices can be paid using a credit card or check. POs can also be added to the invoice as well. If sending a check in the amount of \$1,000 or more, we do ask that you send us the tracking number.

Q: Can Title I funding be used for the Accelerator?

Q: Can I change who has access after we submit our initial group roster?

We understand that a lot can change before the start of a school year. That's why we offer an open enrollment period from August 1st to September 30th, during which groups can make any changes to their participant list. After that timeframe, there will be a fee of \$100 per change request. Multiple changes should be requested at the same time to avoid additional fees. Any group that purchases a site license(50 or more users) is entitled to unlimited changes throughout their membership.
